Where will the new office be?



The South Dunedin MSD / Work and Income office is moving to the new Te Kāika Wellbeing Hub.

Te Kāika Wellbeing Hub is also called **the Hub**.



The Hub is wheelchair accessible.





Ranfurly Street

and

Playfair Street.



If you are coming from South Road the Hub is just after the Mitchell car park.



Our reception / main desk is opposite the main entrance.

There will be someone at the Hub that can help you find your way around.

How do I get to the Hub?



If you are walking then the entrance to the Hub is on Ranfurly Street.



The car park entrance to the Hub is:

- on Playfair Street
- across from the Caversham Community Church.



The Hub parking has:

- free parking spaces
- free accessible parking spaces
- bike racks available.
