

New Zealand Superannuation or Veteran's Pension for Niue residents

If you live in the Cook Islands, Niue and Tokelau you can apply for New Zealand Superannuation (NZ Super) or Veteran's Pension.

To get NZ Super or Veteran's Pension you must:

- be resident in the Cook Islands, Niue or Tokelau
- be aged 65 or over
- have been resident and present in New Zealand for at least 10 years since you turned 20
- have been resident and present in New Zealand, the Cook Islands, Niue and/or Tokelau for at least 5 years since you turned 50 (or a combination of these)
- to be a resident in New Zealand, the Cook Islands, Niue or Tokelau you must have made it your home, and lived there on a permanent basis.

If you live in New Zealand and intend to move to the Cook Islands, Niue or Tokelau, you can still apply for NZ Super or Veteran's Pension. Talk to us before you leave New Zealand.

What you may get

What you may get depends on how long you've lived in New Zealand since the age of 20:

- 20 years or more – the full rate appropriate to you (single or married rate)
- Fewer than 20 years – a rate calculated on the number of years you've lived in New Zealand.

What you get may change if you and/or your partner get or qualify for a social security benefit, pension or allowance from a country other than New Zealand.

How to apply

- You need to complete and sign an application form that you can get from the:
 - New Zealand High Commission in Niue
 - Ministry of Social Development in New Zealand by emailing us at international_services@msd.govt.nz
- Take the form and all the documents we need to the New Zealand High Commission. The documents we need are listed over the page and on the application form.

The date you apply is important

If you're already 65, to make sure you don't miss out on any payments you should collect a form now. If you're approaching 65 years of age, you need to collect a form before your birthday.

What happens next

After you return your application form and the documents we need:

- your form will be checked to make sure it's complete
- copies of your documents will be made and your documents will be given back to you
- your application will be sent securely to New Zealand to be processed.

We'll send you a letter to let you know the outcome of your application.

Documents we need

- What you need to provide depends on your situation.
- One of the documents you provide must be at least two years old.
- If you have a partner who's not receiving NZ Super or Veteran's Pension, you also need to provide proof of their identity.

Proof of your identity

You need to provide one type of government issued identification that has your full legal name and your date of birth. For example your birth certificate, passport driver licence, firearms licence, deed poll. Your legal name is the name on your birth certificate or deed poll for a name change.

If your name has changed, please provide your marriage certificate, deed poll or other proof of the name change.

Documents supporting your identity

Please provide two more documents that support your identity, such as your marriage certificate, bank statement, driver licence or a bill with your name on it.

Proof of your bank account number

You need to provide a bank statement or deposit slip showing the account name, account number and bank logo. If you write any of these details yourself, you need to get the bank to stamp and sign the statement or slip.

Proof you've been resident and present in the Cook Islands, Niue or Tokelau

If you're using your residence and presence in these countries from the age of 50 to qualify for NZ Super or Veteran's Pension, you'll need to provide proof you lived there. You can get it from the Customs or Immigration Office in those places. Ask us if you need help with this.

Supaenuaisoni Niu Silani po ke Penisoni Kautau ma e tau tagata nonofo i Niue

Ka nofo a koe he Atu Kuki Aelani, Niue, po ko Tokelau, maeke a koe ke ole ke moua e Supaenuaisoni Niu Silani (Supa Niu Silani) po ke Penisoni Kautau.

Ke moua e Supa Niu Silani po ke Penisoni Kautau ko koe ni:

- ko e tagata nofo mau ke he Atu Kuki Aelani, Niue, po ko Tokelau
- kua tu e 65 po ke ki luga e tau tau haau he moui
- ne kua nofo mau mo e ha ha i ai i Niu Silani ke he molea 10 e tau, tali mai he molea e tu he 20 e tau tau haau he moui
- ne kua nofo mau mo e ha ha i ai i Niu Silani, Atu Kuki Aelani, Niue mo/po ko Tokelau ke he molea 5 e tau, tali mai he molea e tu he 50 e tau tau haau he moui (po ke lafilafi e tau mena oti na)
- ke totou ko e tagata nofo mau i Niu Silani, Atu Kuki Aelani, Niue, po ko Tokelau kua lata ke kitia ai kua eke kaina ai a koe mo e nofo tumau ke he motu ia.

Kaeke ko koe nofo mau i Niu Silani kae manako ke fina atu ke nofo he Atu Kuki Aelani, Niue po ko Tokelau, ti maeke agaia ni a koe ke ole mai ke moua e Supa Niu Silani po ke Penisoni Kautau. Kumikumi mai kia mautolu a to fano kehe a koe mo Niu Silani.

Ko e fiha e tupe haau ka moua

Ko e tupe haau ka moua, to uta ni ke he leva he nofo haau i Niu Silani tali mai he tu e 20 e tau he moui:

- Ka 20 e tau ki luga – to moua e koe e tupe katoa kua lata (he tokotaha po ke mo e tokoua)
- Ki lalo hifo he 20 e tau – ko e tupe moua to fuafua ni ke he loga he tau ne nofo ai a koe i Niu Silani. Moua foki e falu talahauaga ka kumi atu ke he www.workandincome.govt.nz

Ko e tupe haau ka moua to fai hiki ai foki kaeke ko koe po ke tokoua haau kua moua he penefiti puipuiaga he moui, penisoni po ke tupe moua mai he taha kautu kehe kae nakai ko Niu Silani.

Taute fefe e tohi ole haau

- Kua lata ia koe ke fakapuke mo e saina e pepa tohi ole haau ka moua mai he:
 - Ofisa he Komisina Tokoluga ha Niu Silani i Niue
 - Ministry of Social Development ha Niu Silani ka imeli mai kia mautolu ke he international_services@msd.govt.nz
- Uta e tohi ole mo e tau tohi fakamooli oti kua lata ia mautolu ke moua, ke he ofisa he Komisina Tokoluga. Ko e tau tohi fakamooli ne manako a mautolu ki ai ha na ne tohi he lau na i tua mo e ke he pepa tohi ole.

Ko e mahuiga he aho ne taute ai e tohi ole haau

Kaeke kua fita ni he tu e 65 he tau moui haau, ti kumi a e pepa tohi ole haau ke ua galo noa e ha tupe kua lata ia koe ke moua. Kaeke kua teitei ke tu e 65 haau ti kumi e pepa tohi ole a to hoko e aho fanau haau.

Ko e heigoa foki ke taute

Ka oti he fakafano mai e tohi ole mo e tau tohi fakamooliaga haau to:

- fakakia e mautolu po kua katoatoa oti nakai e tohi ole haau he fakapuke
- taute ai e tau taaki he tau tohi fakamooliaga mo e liuaki atu haau a tau koloa ia kia koe
- fakafano e tohi ole fakapuke haau ki Niu Silani ke fakafita mo e fifili ki ai.

To fakafano atu e mautolu e taha tohi kia koe ke fakailoa atu e fakaotiaga he haau a ole.

Tau fakamooliaga kua lata ia mautolu ke kitia

- Ko e tau tohi fakamooliaga to uta ni ke he tuaga haau fakatagata.
- Ko e taha he tau tohi fakamooliaga haau kua lata ke molea e ua e tau he toka ai e koe.
- Kaeke kua fai tokoua a koe, ne nakai la moua ia he Supa Niu Silani po ke Penisoni Kautau, kua lata ni ke fakakite mai e tau fakamooliaga kia ia.

Ko e fakamooliaga kia koe

Lata ia koe ke fakakite e taha tohi fakamooliaga he fakatufono ne tohia ai e higoa katoa haau mo e aho fanau haau. Ke tuga e tohi aho fanau, pasipoti, laiseni fakaholo, laiseni ke moua e fana, poke fakamooli he hikiaga he higoa. Ko e higoa tohi mooli haau ha ia ke he tohi aho fanau poke tohi fakamooli he hikiaga he higoa haau.

Kaeke kua hiki e higoa haau, ti fakakite e tohi fakamau hoana/taane haau, tohi he hikiaga he higoa poke taha fakamooliaga he hikiaga he higoa haau.

Tau tohi fakamooli kia koe

Fakamolemole fakakite foki ua e tohi fakamooli ma e tau talahauaga kia koe, tuga e tohi fakamau hoana/taane haau, tohi fakailoa moua mo e fakaaoga tupe mai he pege, tohi fakaholo, poke taha tohi totogi kaitalofa ne kua tohia ai e higoa haau.

Fakamooliaga he tohi fakahu tupe haau

Kua lata ke fakakite e taha taaki tohi fakailoa moua mo e fakaaoga tupe mai he pege haau poke laupepa fakahu tupe ne tohi ai e higoa haau, numela he pepa tupe, mo e higoa he pege. Kaeke kua tohi ke he matalima tohi haau, ti kua lata ni ke saini mo e fakamooli he pege e tau talahauaga ia haau.

Fakamooliaga kua nofo a koe he Atu Kuki Aelani, Niue po ko Tokelau

Kaeke kua fakaaoga e koe e haau a nofo ke he taha he tau motu nai tali mai he tu e 50 e tau haau he moui ke moua aki e Supa Niu Silani po ke Penisoni Kautau haau, kua lata ni ke fakakite e koe e tau fakamooliaga kua nofo mooli a koe i ai. Kumikumi atu ke he faahi Kasitomu po ke faahi Oatu mo e Omai he motu. Kumi mai kia mautolu kaeke kua manako lagomatai pihia a koe.
